The Music Therapy track is a comprehensive four-and-a-half year program that prepares candidates for careers as music therapists. Students are in residence in the Department of Music at Cleveland State but take music therapy courses at Baldwin-Wallace College in Berea, Ohio, home of the Cleveland Music Therapy Consortium. The curriculum is approved by the American Music Therapy Association and the program leads to a Bachelor of Music Therapy degree. The Instructional Fee for the program applies only to Music Therapy courses taken at Baldwin-Wallace College at the Cleveland Music Therapy Consortium and is comprised of the CSU undergraduate Instructional Fee rate plus the consortium surcharge. The decrease in the surcharge is the result of increased enrollment in the consortium.

The Program surcharge applies to both Ohio residents and non-residents. Non-resident CSU undergraduate students are subject to the undergraduate out-of-state surcharge on the CSU portion of the Instructional Fee.
